

Is there static on your telemime line? Or does the last player guess the mystery slip?

Form Groups

Players form groups of five or six.

All Out But One

In each group all but one player step out of the room so they cannot see as the leader hands the one remaining player a mystery slip of paper on which is written the action they are to pantomime.

Act What?

Actions may be fairly complex sequences like 1) changing a tire; 2) getting into a car; starting it, begin driving, remember you forgot something, doing a U-turn, driving back, parking, getting out of the car in a hurry; or 3) channel surfing TV, having the phone ring, answering it, talking on the phone while watching TV, having the doorbell ring, answering the door while talking on the phone, receiving and signing for a package delivered to you, struggling to carry the package inside and shut the door while still talking on the phone.

Act 1

After all the first players know what they are to pantomime, the second players from each team are called in. The first players pantomime the action for the second players.

Act 2 (and so on)

Then the third players are called in and see the action from the second player, and so on.

Guess the Mystery Slip
When the last player has a turn, seeing and acting out the sequence, he or she quesses what is written on the original
